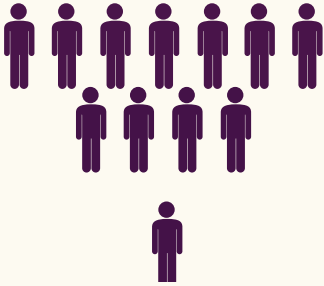

INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM

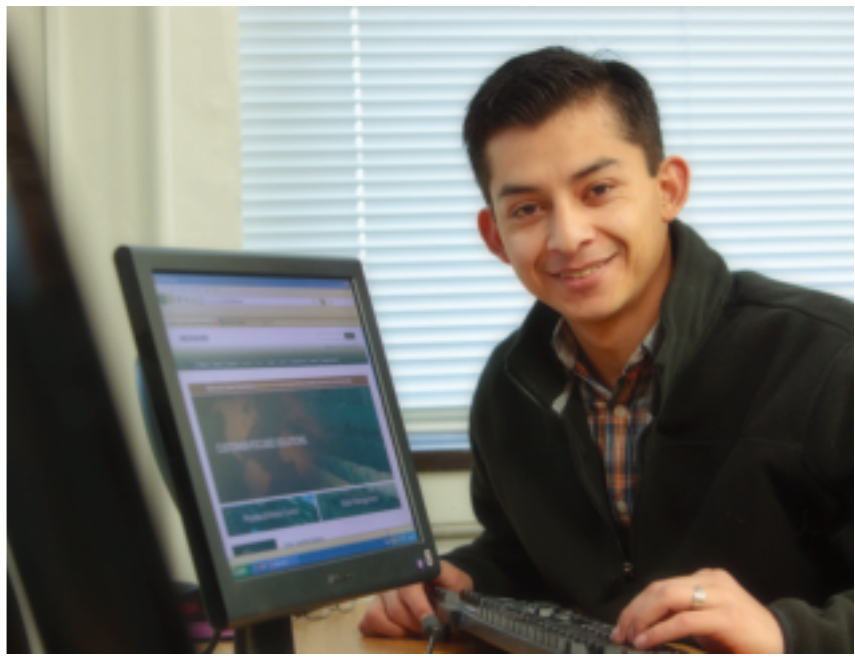
Our unique curriculum is designed to advance non-native English speakers' language skills to communicate effectively in English.
